



The Criteria for inclusion on the West Lancs French Bulldog Club Judging Lists.

A1. For persons who have been approved by the Kennel Club to award CC's in the Breed, have completed their first appointment and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club.

A2. For persons who fulfil all the requirements for list A3 and who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 list and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club.

A3 - Breed Specialists: For persons with a minimum of seven years judging experience in this breed and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club. To have judged a (UK) French Bulldog Breed Club Show or a UK General Championship Show without CC's on offer. To have judged a minimum of 160 French Bulldogs within 40 classes. To have judged the breed at a minimum of 10 Limit, Open or Championship Shows without Challenge Certificates, the shows having an adequate geographical spread with-in the UK. To have attended Seminars given by a Kennel Club and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures, Confirmation and Movement, Points of a Dog and Hands on Assessment. To have attended and passed a French Bulldog Breed Seminar run by one of the French Bulldog Clubs in accordance with the Kennel Club code of Best Practice and to have bred and / or owned a minimum of three French Bulldogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances). To have stewarded on a minimum of twelve days at Shows.

A3 - Non Specialists: For persons with a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed to include five years in French Bulldogs and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club. To have judged a (UK) French Bulldog Breed Club show or a General Championship Show without CC's on offer. To have judged a minimum of 160 French Bulldogs within 40 classes. To have judged the breed at a minimum of 10 Limit, Open Shows or Championship Shows without Challenge Certificates, the shows having an adequate geographical spread with-in the UK. To have awarded CC's in another breed to have attended and passed a French Bulldog Breed Seminar run by a French Bulldog Breed Club in accordance with the Kennel Club code of Best Practice. To have attended Seminars given by a Kennel Club and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures, Confirmation and Movement, Points of a Dog and Hands on Assessment To have bred and / or owned a minimum of three dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).

B - Breed Specialists: To have 4 years owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club. To have passed a French Bulldog Seminar run by a Breed Club in accordance with the Kennel Club Code of Best Practice. To have judged 40 or more French Bulldogs in 12 classes over a minimum period of 4 years or to have attended and passed the West Lancs French Bulldog Breed Seminar in accordance with the Kennel Club Code of Practice. To have attended a Kennel Club Confirmation and Movement Seminar and passed the Hands On Assessment.

B - Non Specialists: To have 4 years owning and exhibiting in any one breed and have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club. To have passed a French Bulldog Breed Seminar run by a breed club in accordance with the Kennel Club Code of Best Practice. To have judged 40 or more French Bulldogs in 12 classes over a minimum period of 4 years or to have attended and passed the West Lancs French Bulldog Breed Seminar run by a breed club in accordance with the Kennel Club Code of Best Practice. To have attended a Kennel Club Confirmation and Movement Seminar and passed the Hands On Assessment.

C . Breed Specialist & Non Specialist For aspiring judges who have the support of the West Lancs French Bulldog Club and who have shown a positive interest in the breed but do not qualify for list B To have attended a Kennel Club Confirmation and Movement Seminar and passed the Hands On Assessment
